Code	Level of Support	Description
T	Transitional	The amount of support (low, medium, high) is provided <u>temporarily</u> to assist a student in gaining independence in new environments, activities, and/or acquisition of new concepts.
L	Low	This support is <u>always available but not needed on a regular basis</u> by the student. The student would be able to function in the environment without the support, just not as successfully.
M	Medium	This support is <u>necessary on a regular basis</u> in order for the student to be successful or to learn in the environment.
H	High	This support is <u>absolutely necessary for the student to learn and must be provided consistently</u> . The student could not function in the environment without the support.
